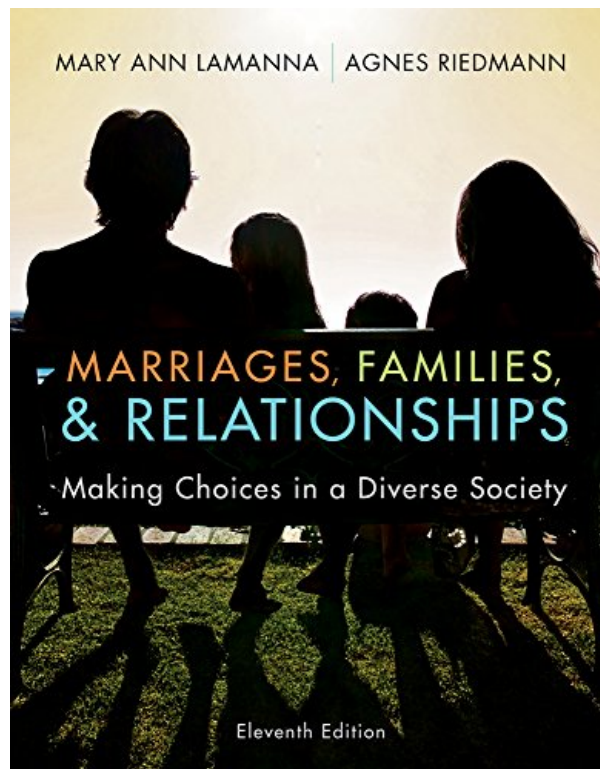
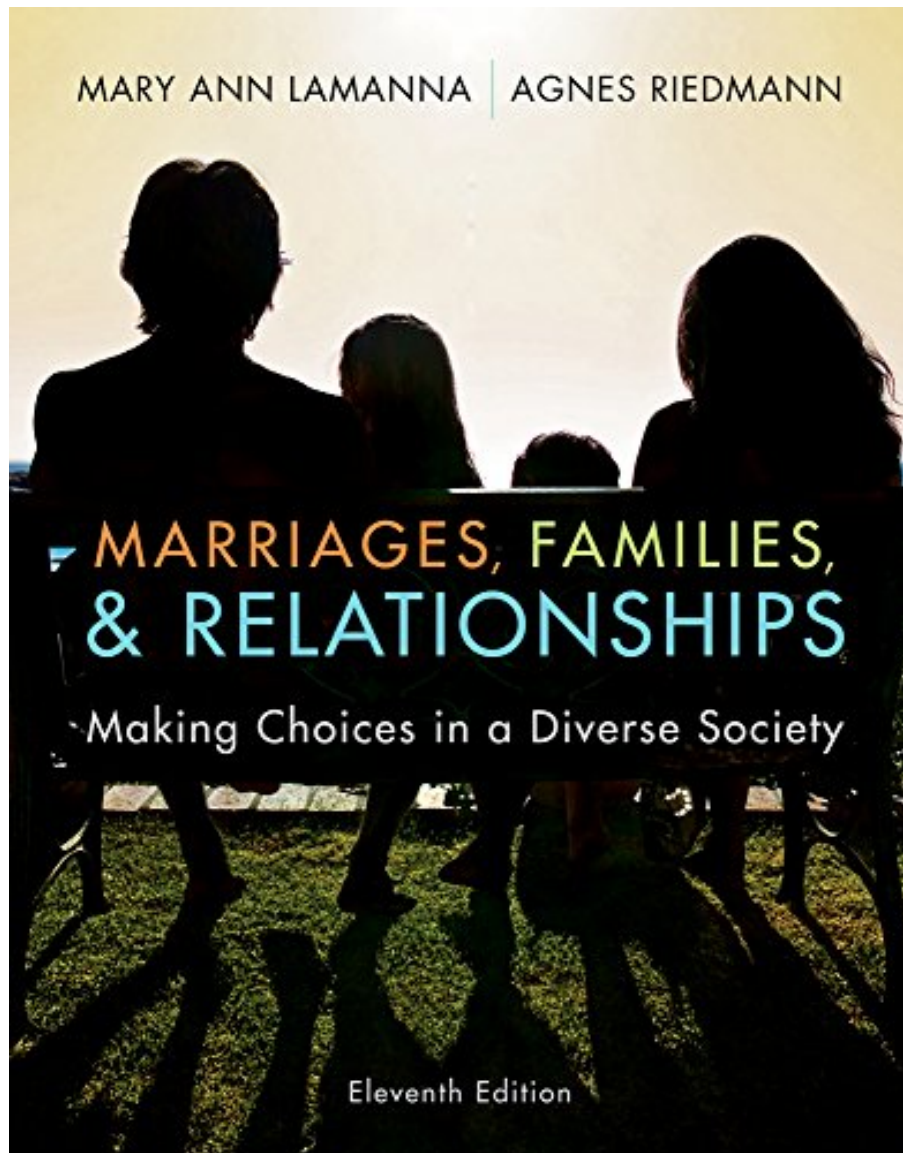

This book is truly terrible. Sure, it contains a few tidbits of information that may be interesting. However, you have to put up with its horrible formatting and blatant promotion of the CengageNow service to get to that. This book is honestly difficult to read because of how badly it's formatted. There are hundreds of pages with extraneous insert blurbs, a few of which take up most of the page, leaving only two or three rows for the actual text underneath it. The only thing this book is 'good' for (and I use that term more than a bit sarcastically) is for passing a class that requires it.

I really enjoyed "Choices in Relationships: An Introduction to Marriage and the Family" by David Knox and Caroline Schacht.
